Mike McBride is a legendary South Jersey high school football coach, who was the head coach at Woodrow Wilson and Winslow High Schools. During his coaching tenure, Coach McBride mentored several current high school head coaches as part of his coaching tree including our very own Coach Crowley. Coach Crowley served as offensive coordinator for Coach McBride at Woodrow Wilson and Winslow. Coach McBride's philosophy of preparation, perseverance, and hard-work has helped several South Jersey football stars like Rashad Baker, Turk McBride, Antwine Perez, Keith Robinson, Reuben Johnson, Ka'Lial Glaud, Bill Belton attend colleges like Tennessee, Southern Cal, Maryland, SMU, Cincinnati, Rutgers, West Virginia and Penn State.



Upon retiring from coaching after the 2011 season, Coach McBride along with Pastor Kevin Brown founded a mentoring program for high school football student athletes called "**A FEW GOOD MEN**" (AFGM). The program uses actual NFL guidelines to teach high school football players across South Jersey how to become better members of society and focuses on five steps to help shape the young minds of high school athletes. To date, the program has reached and changed the lives of over 300+ South Jersey Student athletes.
